I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

County – Webster Route – EB 9004-Edward T. Breathitt (Pennyrille) Parkway/KY 56 Item No. – 2-8637.00 Project Description – Upgrade Sebree Interchange at MP 62 to Interstate Standards.

II. PROJECT INFORMATION

III. PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of this project is to make the necessary improvements at the Edward T. Breathitt Parkway and KY 56 Interchange to be interstate compliant. This interchange is on segment 5 of the I-69 corridor through Kentucky.

This project improves safety and operational characteristics of all traffic entering and exiting the mainline while providing proper level of service in the design year.

IV. DBE REQUIREMENT

The Consultant team shall include a DBE Participation Plan with their response to announcement. An additional page will be allowed with the project approach in the response to announcement to convey this plan. A maximum of 4 points will be considered in the evaluation factors for the DBE Participation Plan.

V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected Consultant will be required to provide engineering services to perform Phase I and Phase II Roadway and Structure Design, including drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans, signing plans, and cost estimates. The Department will provide the lighting plans for the project.

The selected consultant is required to provide engineering services to perform an IJS with expected deliverable of preliminary interchange layouts and cost estimates (construction and right-of-way). Study limits are from Exit 54, KY 138 to Exit 68, KY 416 on the Edward T. Breathitt (Pennyrile) Parkway.
