V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected consultant will be required to provide engineering services and develop retrofit/rehabilitation plans for the reconstruction of the Indiana Approach sidewalks. This includes the upstream and downstream sidewalks, structural steel repairs and other miscellaneous items. These repairs will be similar in nature to the repairs performed on the Kentucky approach in 2010.

VI. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Kentucky approach repairs were performed in 2010 and are complete. It is expected that that the consultant will utilize the same repair scheme and design for the Indiana approach. Existing design files will be made available to the selected consultant to utilize design details from the 2010 rehabilitation of the Kentucky approach. Site visits may be required by the selected consultant to verify and quantify existing conditions.
