III. P URPOSE AND NEED

A. The purpose of this bridge replacement is to replace a 27 year old, Steel Stringer/Multibeam or Girder Bridge (018C00107N) in order to provide a safe, reliable roadway. The existing bridge on CR 1464 over Smith Branch Creek has a sufficiency rating of 37.9 and an 8 ton posting. The structure width is 18 feet curb to curb with an approaching roadway width of 14.1 feet including shoulders. The steel box girder and open girder have moderate to heavy rust. The concrete deck has moderate wear with random cracks. The bridge replacement will improve safety and the substandard condition of the bridge.

B. The purpose of this bridge replacement is to replace a 41 year old, 1-span Multiple Box Beam Bridge (111B00054N) in order to provide a safe reliable roadway. The existing bridge on KY 1585, MP 4.86, over Sinking Fork Creek has a sufficiency rating of 19.7 and a 3 ton posting. The deck is an asphalt overlay on box beams with minor to moderate deterioration. All timbers piles have moderate to heavy deterioration. The bridge replacement will improve safety and the substandard condition of the bridge.

The selected Consultant will provide engineering services to perform Phase I and Phase II Roadway Design, including drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans, and cost estimates.


XVII. EVALUATION FACTORS


