Project Description - Reconstruct KY 30 from the intersection of KY 11 at Levi to Jct. of KY 847 at Travelers Rest.

The purpose of this project is to take the Phase I Preferred Alignment and produce Right-of-Way Plans and Final Grade, Drain and Surfacing Plans.

KY 30 Reconstruction is needed to improve regional connectivity by improving both horizontal/vertical geometrics and the typical section which will improve safety along the route. The ultimate goal is to improve route from Hal Rogers Parkway to KY 11 at Levi. District 11 has KY 30 either constructed or under construction from Hal Rogers Parkway to KY 421 at Tyner.
