III. PURPOSE AND NEED

A. Purpose: The bridge is classified as functionally obsolete. According to the Structure Inventory and Appraisal Sheet, the bridge received an intolerable rating for the deck geometry. KY 72 has several sharp curves both north and south of the bridge. These may be improved as part of the bridge project. Replacement of the bridge will provide a safer and more reliable access for the local community.

Need: This bridge is functionally obsolete with a sufficiency rating of 30.

B. Purpose: By replacing the bridge, CR 1184 in Bell County will allow safer and more reliable access for the local community to access KY 1344. Need: This bridge is structurally deficient and functionally obsolete. It has a sufficiency rating of 12.9.
