This document constitutes a Request for Proposals for Personal Service Contract from qualified individuals and organizations to furnish those services as described herein for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Department of Highways.

I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

County - Perry Route – KY 15 Item No. 10-158.00

Project Description – Improve safety, upgrade geometrics, and address capacity issues for KY 15 in Perry County from Morton Boulevard to KY 15 Bypass.

III. PURPOSE AND NEED

The KY 15 corridor is a vital arterial route into the Appalachian region of Kentucky. Eastern Kentucky has a lack of sufficient transportation infrastructure and system linkage. This section of KY 15 has geometric deficiencies and high traffic volumes, which leads to safety problems. The purpose of this project is to provide a safer and more efficient corridor, and to contribute to the transportation infrastructure improvements needed to support and enhance economic vitality in Eastern Kentucky.

IV. DBE REQUIREMENT

The Consultant team shall include a DBE Participation Plan with their response to announcement. An additional page will be allowed with the project approach in the Response to Announcement to convey this plan. A maximum of 4 points will be considered in the evaluation factors for the DBE Participation Plan.

V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected consultant will be required to conduct Preliminary Engineering studies to identify appropriate typical sections, utility impacts, line and grade, and a dependable cost estimate. Traffic Engineering Analysis will also be required for this project to analyze capacity issues and appropriate solutions.

The consultant will also be responsible for the development of an approved environmental document for this project in Preliminary Engineering. It is anticipated to be an EA/FONSI at this time.

The selected consultant will be required to provide engineering services to perform Final Roadway Design. Final Roadway Design will include the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right of way plans, construction plans, structure plans, traffic control plans, and cost estimates.
