III. PURPOSE AND NEED

US 27 is the major route for freight into and out of Pendleton County, and is the most direct route to the population centers of Cincinnati and Lexington. Despite the addition of truck climbing lanes there are deficiencies in shoulder width, access management, intersection sight distance, or vertical alignment. Reconstruct US 27 to current design standards.

This project may be advanced to Final Roadway Design, with a Contract Modification. The selected consultant may then be required to provide engineering services to perform Final Roadway Design.

For state-funded projects, if a Selection Committee vote results in a tie between two (2) firms, one (1) of which will perform more of the work tasks in Kentucky than the other, then the former firm shall be ranked one (1) place ahead of the latter.


