## III. PURPOSE AND NEED

KY 32 is a heavily traveled connection from Flemingsburg to $1-64$ in Morehead. Vertical grade and sight distance deficiencies occur throughout the project resulting in collision patterns at several approaches. This reconstruction ends at the entrance of three schools, a community technical college, and commercial development. This section of roadway also has a lumber yard, factory, and several local businesses contributing to the mobility and safety issues throughout this corridor. This route carried an ADT of 9551 according to a 2012 traffic count.

The purpose of this project is address geometric deficiencies to improve safety and congestion along KY 32 between MP 2.2 and MP 4.2.

## V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected consultant will be responsible for Preliminary Engineering and Final Roadway Design, including the preparation of preliminary line and grade plans, traffic engineering analysis, drainage design, right of way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans, and cost estimates. Final Roadway Design may be added to the contract agreement by contract
modification when Preliminary Engineering is complete. The selected Consultant will also be required to provide engineering services to perform Structure Design.

5. Consultant's offices where work is to be performed. (2 Points)

For state-funded projects, if a Selection Committee vote results in a tie between two (2) firms, one (1) of which will perform more of the work tasks in Kentucky than the other, then the former firm shall be ranked one (1) place ahead of the latter.
