County – Warren Route – KY 234 Item No – 3-1077.00

Project Description – Replace bridge on KY 234 over Drakes Creek 0.097 east of Shaker Mill Road (SR 42.8) (114B00012N).

III. PURPOSE AND NEED

Need: KY 234 is a Rural Major Collector which provide a connection between the center of Bowling Green to eastern Warren County and Scottsville, including access to the Barren River Lake. This narrow bridge has been identified as structurally deficient (rating of 42.8) and functionally obsolete at the point where the road transitions from a wide urban road to a narrow, widening rural road.

Purpose: The purpose of this improvement is to increase the safety and reliability of the bridge on KY 234 over Drakes Creek and to ease the transition from the urban multi-laned typical section to the narrow rural road.

V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected consultant will be required to provide engineering services to perform Preliminary Engineering and Final Roadway Design and Structure Design. Preliminary Engineering includes line and grade plans analyzing various alternatives with the goal of keeping the existing bridge open to two-way, two-lane traffic during construction. Preliminary Engineering also includes

traffic engineering analysis as per Design Memo 03-11, preliminary drainage, and cost estimates. Final Roadway Design including storm water construction and post construction Best Management Practices (BMP), signing and pavement marking plans, traffic control plans, structure plans, final cost estimates, and an anticipated construction schedule.
