I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

County – Martin Route – KY 40 Item No. 12-192.00

Project Description – Improve alignment and geometrics of the curve located just before the junction of KY 2031/KY 40 to 0.1 mile before Gordon Hollow Road and improve the culvert/safety design to increase motorist/pedestrian safety

II. PROJECT INFORMATION

Project Manager – Samuel Hale, P.E. User Division – Highway Design Approximate Fee – Design \$350,000 Project Funding – State Funds (SPP) Project Length – Approximately 0.2 miles

III. PURPOSE AND NEED

Substandard geometrics of the curve located near the junction of KY 2031 and deficiencies in the culvert contribute to safety issues with this section of KY 40. The purpose of the project is to improve safety through this section of KY 40 primarily through geometrics including a relocated alignment, construction of a new bridge and/or culvert, and a reconstructed intersection with KY 2031.

The selected consultant will be required to provide engineering services to perform Preliminary Engineering and Final Roadway Design, including the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans, cost estimates, and an anticipated construction schedule.

For state-funded projects, if a Selection Committee vote results in a tie between two (2) firms, one (1) of which will perform more of the work tasks in Kentucky than the other, then the former firm shall be ranked one (1) place ahead of the latter.
