# III. PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of this project is to replace each of these substandard bridges with a safe, structurally sound, structure.

## IV. DBE REQUIREMENT

The Consultant team shall include a DBE Participation Plan with their response to announcement. An additional page will be allowed with the project approach in the Response to Announcement to convey this plan. A maximum of 4 points will be considered in the evaluation factors for the DBE Participation Plan.

## V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected consultant will be responsible to provide Phase I and Phase II Roadway Design, including the preparation of preliminary line and grade plans, drainage design, right of way plans, and final construction plans, with corresponding construction costs estimates, including traffic control and erosion control plans, and advance situation folders for structure design. The selected consultant will also be required to provide engineering services to perform structure design. Each of these existing structures is likely considered historic, with the construction dates of each dating back to the mid 1930's.

# VIII. METHOD OF DESIGN

The selected Consultant shall utilize the most recent CADD Standards for Highway Plans Policy in the development of the highway plans.

## X. GEOTECHNICAL SERVICES

The Department will provide all Geotechnical Services for the Project.

# XI. STRUCTURE DESIGN

The selected consultant shall provide the necessary engineering services to submit an Advanced Situation Folder(s) to the KYTC for the appropriate applicable structure(s). The structure design will be performed by the consultant. Prequalification in the area of structure design is required to be identified in the Consultant's Response to Announcement.

# XII. TRAFFIC

Traffic volumes will be counted by the Department and an updated traffic forecast, if necessary, will be provided to the selected consultant.

## XIII. PHOTOGRAMMETRIC SERVICES/ SURVEY

The selected consultant is to field survey each project.

# XIV. UTILITY DESIGN

The selected consultant shall locate all existing utilities and locate them on the plans provided to the Department. The Department will develop the utility contact list. All utilities including aerial carriers shall be field-verified by the consultant. Sizes and types of underground and aerial utilities shall be identified on the plans.

The Department will authorize B.U.D. (Before You Dig) to field-locate utilities during Phase II design. The consultant shall perform field surveys to collect the B.U.D. data. Horizontal location of existing utilities shown on Phase II plans shall be adjusted as necessary to reflect actual B.U.D. locates.

# XVIII. EVALUATION FACTORS

Consultants will be evaluated by the selection committee based on the following, weighted factors:

- 1. Relative experience of consultant personnel assigned to project team with highway project for KYTC and/or federal, local or other state governmental agencies. (15 Points)
- 2. Capacity to comply with project schedule. (10 Points)
- 3. Past record of performance on projects similar in type and complexity. (15 Points)
- 4. Project approach and proposed procedures to accomplish the services for the project. (20 Points)

- 5. DBE Participation Plan (4 Points)
- 6. Consultant's offices where work is to be performed. (2 Points)

For state-funded projects, if a Selection Committee vote results in a tie between two (2) firms, one (1) of which will perform more of the work tasks in Kentucky than the other, then the former firm shall be ranked one (1) place ahead of the latter.
