Elevating these portions of the roadway and the bridge to a minimum elevation of 971.0' will greatly reduce these occurrences without creating additional flooding concerns.

Final Roadway design will include the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right of way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans and cost estimates as necessary to provide Final Grade, Drain and Surfacing Plans for the project.
