III. PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of this project is to address the structural deficiencies of the overflow structure and roadway deficiencies on the bridge in order to provide a safe passage on the section of US 431. The existing bridge has a sufficiency rating of 39. This segment of US 431 is a designated coal haul route.

IV. DBE REQUIREMENT

Consultant team may include a DBE Participation Plan with their Response to Announcement. An additional page will be allowed with the Project Approach (page 7) in the Response to Announcement to convey this plan. A maximum of 4 points will be considered in the evaluation factors for the DBE Participation Plan.

The selected Consultant will be responsible for Preliminary Engineering and Final Roadway Design, including the preparation of preliminary line and grade plans, drainage design, right-of-

way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans, cost estimates, and advanced situation folders for structural design.

For state-funded projects, if a Selection Committee vote results in a tie between two (2) firms, one (1) of which will perform more of the work tasks in Kentucky than the other, then the former firm shall be ranked one (1) place ahead of the latter.
