#### III. PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of this project is to improve safety and mobility along KY 1008.

#### V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected consultant will be required to provide engineering services to perform Preliminary Engineering, Final Roadway Design, Geotechnical Engineering and Traffic Engineering. Preliminary Engineering includes line and grade plans, preliminary drainage, and cost estimates. Final Roadway Design includes, at a minimum, preparation of drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans including storm water construction and post construction Best Management Practices (BMP), signing and pavement marking plans, traffic control plans, and final cost estimates. Geotechnical Engineering includes all field work and lab work necessary to provide a Geotechnical Roadway and Structure Report. Traffic Engineering includes design and preparation of traffic signal plans and temporary signal phasing.

#### VIII. METHOD OF DESIGN

The selected Consultant shall utilize the most recent CADD Standards for Highway Plans Policy in the development of the highway plans.

Any necessary Environmental Services will be provided by the Department. It is anticipated that an Environmental Overview will be prepared and provided to the Consultant for consideration during evaluation of alternatives.

# X. PHOTOGRAMMETRIC SERVICES

The Department will be responsible for obtaining mapping and LIDAR data. The selected Consultant shall supplement this information with conventional surveying as needed.

### XI. STRUCTURE DESIGN

The Consultant shall provide the necessary engineering service to submit an Advanced Situation Folder(s) to the KYTC for the appropriate applicable structure(s). The Structure Design will be performed by the Department. Prequalification in the area of structure design is not required to be identified in the consultant's Response to Announcement.

#### XII. GEOTECHNICAL SERVICES

The Consultant will provide all Geotechnical Services required for the project.

#### XIII. TRAFFIC

The Traffic projections and related information will be provided by the Department. The Consultant will be responsible for providing Traffic Signal Plans.

The selected consultant shall locate all existing utilities and locate them on the plans provided to the Department. The Department will develop the utility contact list. All utilities including aerial carriers shall be field-verified by the consultant. Sizes and types of underground and aerial utilities shall be identified on the plans.

### XVIII. EVALUATION FACTORS

Consultants will be evaluated by the selection committee based on the following, weighted factors:

- 1. Relative experience of consultant personnel assigned to project team with highway project for KYTC and/or federal, local or other state governmental agencies. (15 Points)
- 2. Capacity to comply with project schedule. (10 Points)
- 3. Past record of performance on projects similar in type and complexity. (10 Points)
- 4. Project approach and proposed procedures to accomplish the services for the project. (20 Points)

5. Consultant's offices where work is to be performed. (5 Points)

For state-funded projects, if a Selection Committee vote results in a tie between two (2) firms, one (1) of which will perform more of the work tasks in Kentucky than the other, then the former firm shall be ranked one (1) place ahead of the latter.
