III. PURPOSE AND NEED

When KY 1274 was constructed it had little to no slope stability benches created to stabilize the rock cuts. The work will consist of correcting rock fall issues associated with vertical rock cuts along KY 1274 south of the Menifee/Rowan County line. The existing slopes will be cut to construct benches and a wider shoulder. These improvements will address the dangerous rockslides that have been happening through this corridor and expose more roadway surface to the sun during the winter.

V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected Consultant will be responsible for Preliminary Engineering and Final Roadway Design, including the preparation of preliminary line and grade and grade plans, drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans, cost estimates, and advanced situation folders for structural design.

Final Roadway Design includes, at a minimum, preparation of drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans including storm water construction and post construction Best Management Practices (BMP), signing and pavement marking plans, traffic control plans, final cost estimates, and an anticipated construction schedule. Lighting plans will also be required.

The Department will be responsible for obtaining the aerial photography and will furnish manuscripts on computer disks in DGN format.

XI. STRUCTURE DESIGN

Structure Design is not anticipated for Preliminary Design. For Final Design, if necessary the consultant shall do the necessary engineering services to submit to the KYTC an Advanced Situation Folder(s) for the appropriate structure(s).

XII. GEOTECHNICAL SERVICES

The Department will provide all Geotechnical Services required for the project.

XIII. TRAFFIC

The Traffic projections and related information will be provided by the Department.

The selected Consultant shall locate all existing utilities and locate them on the plans provided to the Department. The Department will develop the utility contact list. All utilities including aerial carriers shall be field-verified by the Consultant. Sizes and types of underground and aerial utilities shall be identified on the plans.

- 4. Capacity to comply with project schedule. (10 Points)
- 5. Consultant's offices where work is to be performed. (2 Points)

For state-funded projects, if a Selection Committee vote results in a tie between two (2) firms, one (1) of which will perform more of the work tasks in Kentucky than the other, then the former firm shall be ranked one (1) place ahead of the latter.
