Project Description - Proposed improvements begin just south of Murray at the Clarks River extending southward to the Tennessee state line at Hazel.

III. PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct US 641 to improve opportunity for freight movement and increase safety by modifying geometrics to meet current design standards.

V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected Consultant will be required to provide environmental services such as developing technical baseline studies, including but not limited to: noise, socioeconomic, aquatic and terrestrial, cultural historic and archaeological, and UST/HAZMAT. The Consultant will also be responsible for the completion of a final environmental document, which is anticipated to be an Environmental Assessment/Finding of No Significant Impact. Heretofore, the project has been state-funded and KYTC intends to develop the project in accordance with NEPA requirements and potentially seek federal funding for future phases. The selected Consultant will be expected to work with the design firm already under contract for the project, as necessary to complete the

work. Information developed to date is represented by documents made available in Section VII Previous Studies.

Consultants will be evaluated by the selection committee based on the following, weighted factors:


1. Project approach and proposed procedures to accomplish the services for the project. (20 Points)
2. Relative experience of consultant personnel assigned to project team with highway project for KYTC and/or federal, local or other state governmental agencies. (15 Points)
3. Past record of performance on projects similar in type and complexity. (15 Points)
4. Capacity to comply with project schedule. (10 Points)
5. Consultant's offices where work is to be performed. (2 Points)

For state-funded projects, if a Selection Committee vote results in a tie between two (2) firms, one (1) of which will perform more of the work tasks in Kentucky than the other, then the former firm shall be ranked one (1) place ahead of the latter.
