The State Historic Preservation Office has received for review and apprival the above referenced cultural historic survey determination of eligibility and effect. The survey identified nine sites and found them to be ineligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. We concur that Site 1 (Ba-59), Site 2 (Ba-135), Site 3 (Ba-60), Site 4 (Ba-136), Site 5 (Ba-137), Site 6 (Ba-138), Site 7 (Ba-52), Site 8 (Ba-39) and Site 9 (Ba-140) fail to meet NRHP criteria and are, therefore, ineligible for listing. In accordance with 36CFR Part 800.4(d) of the Advisory Council's revised regulations our finding is that there are No Historic Properties affected within the undertaking area of potential impact.

The State Historic Preservation Office has received for review and comment the above-referenced report completed by Craig Potts and Lori O'Connor of Cultural Resource Analysts, Inc. The proposed undertaking consists of the widening of US 60 from two lanes to four lanes from the proposed southern bypass of La Center to 1 mile east of Denis Jones Road in Ballard County.

Three previously identified historic resources were located within the area surveyed for this report: Site 1 and Site 8 (BA-141) and Site 5 (BA-54). The latter is, according to the authors, no longer extant.

We concur with the authors that Site 1 (BA-141), Site 2 (BA-152), Site 3 (BA-153), Site 4 (BA-154), Site 7 (BA-156) are not eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) individually or within the context of a historic district.

Site 6 (BA-155) does appear eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A as a rural historic district. According to your letter of March 19, 2008, the proposed project bisects this site. Therefore, it is the determination of this office that this undertaking will have an Adverse Effect on Site 6. Thank you for your letter concerning the eligibility determination and re-evaluation of the abovelisted project. Pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. Sec. 470f) and implementing regulations at 36 C.F.R. Part 800, the Kentucky Heritage Council (SHPO) received for review and comment information regarding the above-referenced project.

We understand from the two meetings attended at KYTC with members of KYTC-DEA and AECOM/Qk4 that the historic property known as the Eagle Rest Plantation has changed since the 2007 evaluation. These changes include the loss of the former dwelling due to fire. Furthermore, the site is essentially abandoned and with the partial demolition of the mule barn, we concur with the recommendation that the Eagle's Rest Plantation is no longer eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP).
