QUESTION: Regarding Evaluation Factor #5, "The Consultant demonstrates a comprehensive understanding of safety strategies and the ability to generate meaningful ideas that can measurably enhance the safety of the completed project. This includes both the immediate effectiveness and the long-term safety impacts of the finished facility." How does this apply to the Cultural Historic & Archaeological Studies Statewide since this work does not result in a design for the 'finished facility'?
