WHEREAS, the Policy Committee is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Bowling Green - Warren County MPO urbanized area; and

WHERAS, the transportation planning process is being carried out in conformance with all Federal requirements and has been so certified and all federally funded highway and transit projects must be in the TIP prior to expenditure of funds; and

WHEREAS, the amendment described in this resolution to the <u>Bowling Green - Warren County 2024-2028 Transportation Improvement Program</u> have been developed by the MPO staff in consultation with, and is recommended by, the MPO Technical Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that these amendments have been developed in accordance with the MPO Participation Plan; and

WHEREAS, these amendments are consistent with the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act requirements related to nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs; and

WHEREAS, this amendment will result in a MTP and TIP that remains fiscally constrained; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Policy Committee of the Bowling Green - Warren County MPO hereby amends the Bowling Green - Warren County 2024-2028 Transportation Improvement Program to add the attached listing of projects.

ACTION:

The Bowling Green-Warren County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) hereby amends the 2024-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This amendment reflects the addition of two projects to build EV charging stations. This amendment allows the utilization of federal Electric Vehicle funds allocated to KYTC for buildout of Kentucky's portion of a nationwide EV charging network.

PROJECT #: 1

<u>DESCRIPTION:</u> KYTC will provide \$22,267.08 (80%) in federal EV funds for the design of the facility and \$491,912.37 (80%) for construction. The remaining 20% of design (\$5,566.77) and 20% of construction (\$122,978.22) costs will be provided by the developer.

<u>SCOPE OF WORK:</u> Install EV charging station on Russellville Rd. - Francis Energy

<u>DESCRIPTION:</u> KYTC will provide \$54,000.00 (80%) in federal EV funds for the design of the facility and \$516,560.00 (58%) for construction. The remaining 20% of design (\$13,500.00) and 42% of construction (\$371,640.00) costs will be provided by the developer.

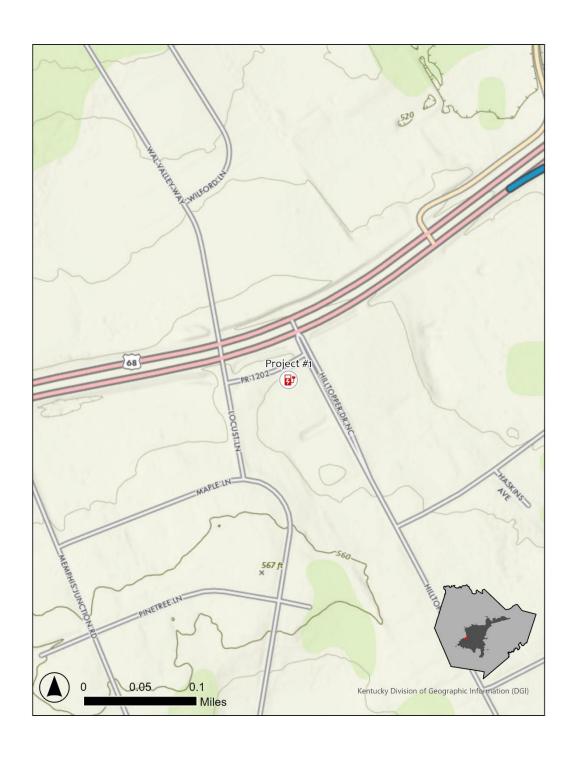

<u>FISCAL CONSTRAINT:</u> \$570,560.00 in EV funds are being allocated by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, with \$385,140.00 in local match funds being provided by the developer, maintaining fiscal constraint.

Other Information: This TIP Amendment amends specific funding levels for two (2) additional EV projects that are itemized in *Table 4 (Federally Funded Projects)* of the TIP. This action involves a commitment of additional funding for the project by the project sponsor (Kentucky Transportation Cabinet). This funding maintains financial constraint of the TIP documents, and no additional financial constraint analysis by the MPO is needed.

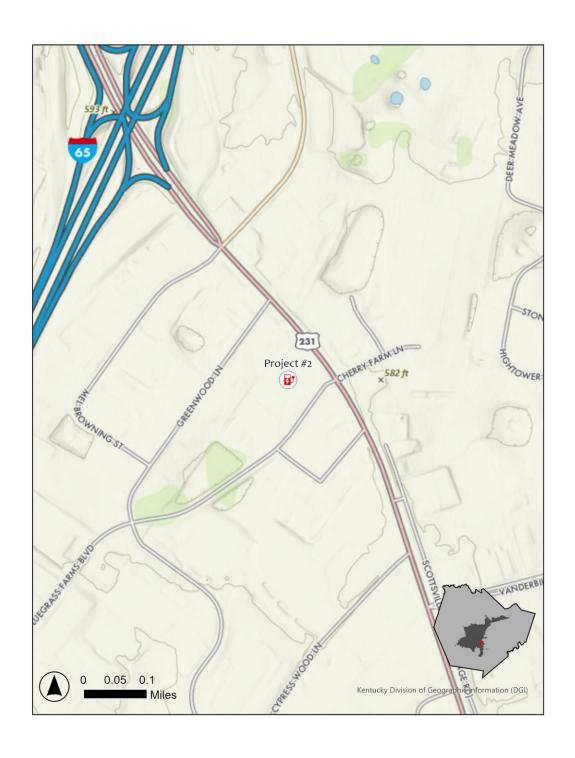
