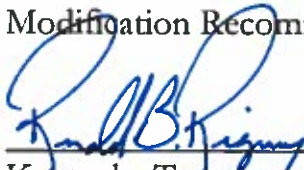

ACTION:

The Radcliff/Elizabethtown Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) hereby modifies the FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to reflect project phases and funding from the enacted 2018 Kentucky Highway Plan. This modification reflects the addition of Bridge Replacement (BR) and Pavement Management (PM) funding types and projects. The projects included in this modification are highlighted in Table 7 (attached).

Bridge Replacement; Bridge Rehabilitation; and Pavement Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation projects are classified as Grouped Projects in the TIP; therefore a formal amendment is not necessary.

Funding has been approved or identified for these projects; therefore a new fiscal constraint analysis by the MPO is not necessary.
