

Modification Descriptions

Ref #1 is considered exempt from the requirements to determine conformity based on 40 CFR 93.126 *Table 2 Exempt Projects – Transportation Enhancement Activities*. KYOVA's 2018-2021 TIP, MTP and KYOVA's Participation Plan consider Transportation Enhancement activities as non-controversial and produce negligible impacts-other than positive benefits for safety, traffic operations, system preservation, etc., and is included in the Groupable Project List Item # BG-135.

Ref #2 is considered exempt from the requirements to determine conformity based on 40 CFR 93.126 *Table 2 Exempt Projects – Safety – Pavement resurfacing and/or rehabilitation and Safer non-Federal-aid system roads and Other – Transportation Enhancement Activities*. KYOVA's 2018-2021 TIP, MTP and Participation Plan considers Pavement resurfacing/rehabilitation projects as non-controversial and produce negligible impacts-other than positive benefits for safety, traffic operations, system preservation, etc., and is included in the Groupable Project List Item # BG-100 and #BG 135, respectively.

Ref #3 is considered exempt from the requirements to determine conformity based on 40 CFR 93.126 *Table 2 Exempt Projects – Safety– Railroad/highway crossing warning devices and Railroad/highway crossing*. KYOVA's 2018-2021 TIP, MTP and KYOVA's Participation Plan consider Railroad/highway crossing safety improvements and warning devices non-controversial and produce negligible impacts-other than positive benefits for safety, traffic operations, system preservation, etc., and is included in the Groupable Project List Item # BG-125. In accordance with 23 U. S. C. 120(c), this project is eligible for 100% federal funding.

Justification

To modify KYOVA's 2018-2021 TIP, KYOVA's 2040 MTP, and the current KY STIP to include the above projects funded by KYOVA suballocated funds (SAH) through the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBGP). KYOVA committee members were notified of this modification on June 28, 2019.
