#### **Modification Description**

To modify KYOVA's 2018-2021 TIP and KYOVA's 2040 MTP t reflect purchase of 2 replacement buses with Sections 5307 and 5339 funds.

#### **Justification**

As stated in KYOVA's Amendment #7 - FTA 5307 funding for the City of Ashland to purchase two 24/2 Cuta-way buses from the Kentucky Public Transit Authority for FY 2019. Total cost for <u>each</u>  $24 \times 2$  cut-a-way bus = \$93,025 (Total for both buses = \$186,050). The new buses will serve as replacement vehicles. *Note:* Each funding source has been split - 5307 funds = \$35,271 / 5339 funds = \$113,569, & Local funds = \$37,210.
