

ACTION:

The Radcliff/Elizabethtown Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) hereby modifies the FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This modification reflects the addition of the following Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) project:

DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION:

BP-18-03 – Removal of existing, unsafe walkway on the west side of Main Street in conjunction with the new sidewalk project previously approved on the East side of Main Street. 860' of unsafe sidewalk and 200' of deteriorating retaining wall. – Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) – Federal-\$160,000, Local-\$39,936, TOTAL-\$199,936


Surface Transportation Block Grant Set-Aside (formerly Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) project types are classified as Grouped Projects in the TIP; therefore, a formal amendment is not required.

FISCAL CONSTRAINT: Funding for these improvements has been committed by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC); therefore, financial constraint of the TIP is maintained, as demonstrated in Table 11.
