Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #4 to

the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On August 23, 2019, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #21 to the FY 2017 – 2020 TIP.

Administrative Modification #21:

This action updates the previously published TIP document and tables. The modification updates existing projects which were awarded TAP funding, and adds a transit project that was recently awarded a Low-Emissions Deployment Program Grant. These projects are considered Grouped Projects* which do not impact the financial constraint of the TIP. The modifications are:

Table 6A – Grouped Projects Selected (All project phases below are programmed for FY 2020):

- New Low Emissions Deployment Program Grant Project:
 - Lextran Covered storage area and the incremental cost of additional zero emission vehicles.
 - \$2.750,000 for Design & Construction (\$2,200,000 FTA 5339 + \$550,000 Local)

 - Old Todds Road Sidewalks
 - \$260,000 for Construction (\$208,000 TAP + \$52,000 Local)
 - o Citation Trail (Phase 1)
 - \$365,000 for Construction (\$292,000 TAP + \$73,000 Local)
 - East High Shared Use Trail
 - \$68,000 for Design (\$54,000 TAP + \$14,000 Local)
 - \$457,000 for ROW (\$366,000 TAP + \$91,000 Local)
 - \$180,000 for Utilities (\$144,000 TAP + \$36,000 Local)
 - West High Shared Use Trail
 - \$80,000 for Design (\$64,000 TAP + \$16,000 Local)
 - \$192,000 for ROW (\$154,000 TAP + \$38,000 Local)
 - \$48,000 for Utilities (\$38,000 TAP + \$10,000 Local)

TIP actions for these projects will not require additional public review, demonstration of fiscal constraint, or a conformity determination (if applicable).
