

SUBJECT: Notification of Administrative Modification #29 to the FY 2017–FY 2020 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #12 to the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On May 6, 2020, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #29 to the FY 2017 – 2020 TIP and Modification #12 to the 2045 MTP.

Administrative Modification #29:

This action updates the previously published TIP document and tables. The modifications are:

Brighton Rail Trail Bridge Phase IV:

- Update funding for the construction phase from \$1,975,000 to \$2,888,000.
The additional \$913,000 will be federal SLX funds matched with toll credits

US 169 (North 3rd St) Bridge:

- Add an additional \$185,000 in funding for construction
\$148,000 - Federal (SLX) 80% + \$37,000 – Local Match 20%

The updated TIP table adding SLX funding to the projects are shown on the following page. The Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality funding for the Brighton Rail Trail Bridge project and Bridge Replacement funding for the US 169 Railroad Bridge is also shown for reference.
