**SUBJECT:** Notification of **Administrative Modification #5** to the FY 2021 – FY 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #24 to the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

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On June 24, 2021, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #5 to the FY 2021 – 2024 TIP and Modification #24 to the 2045 MTP.

### **Administrative Modification #5:**

This action updates the previously published documents and tables. All projects in this modification are considered Grouped Projects\* which do not impact the financial constraint of the TIP.

#### **East Fayette Trail Connectivity Study**

- Grouped Project: Planning and Technical Studies
- Update the total cost for this study from \$100,000 to \$150,000

#### **Town Branch Trail Crossing**

- Grouped Project: Bike/Ped Facilities
- Transfer \$50,000 from the construction phase to the design phase to cover redesign costs to remove the need for a retaining wall and avoid a right-of-way issue and utility conflict

#### **Northeast New Circle Road Corridor Plan**

- Grouped Project: Planning and Technical Studies
- Add a new coordinated corridor land use plan and transportation study for the signalized portion of Northeast New Circle Road
