

The Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization has processed the following administrative modifications to the FY 2022-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

TIP Administrative Modifications

- ID# 02-382 Wathen Lane from US 60 to the City limits: Add the right of way and utility phases previously listed for FY 2021 obligation to FY 2022. The phases will be funded with a combination of Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) funding, Federal SHN Funds and Local match.
- ID# 02-321 Green River Road from Bend Gate Rd to the Osage Dr: Move Construction (CN) from FY 2022 to FY 2023. The phase will be funded with Federal TE/TAP Funds and Local match.
