**SUBJECT:** Notification of **Administrative Modification #40** to the FY 2021 – FY 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #58 to the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On October 27, 2023, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #40 to the FY 2021 – 2024 TIP and Modification #58 to the 2045 MTP.

**Administrative Modification #40:**

This action updates the previously published documents and tables. This modification combines two existing grouped projects<sup>1</sup> (Bike/Ped Facilities) which does not impact the financial constraint of the TIP, and adds supplementary funding<sup>2</sup> to the updated project.

**Wilson-Downing & Squires Rd Sidewalks:**

This modification combines the existing **Squires Rd Sidewalks** and **Wilson Downing Sidewalks** projects and adds \$1,250,000 (\$1,000,000 in Federal STBG-SLX (80%) + \$250,000 Local Match (20%)) to the construction phase to cover cost increases.

<sup>2</sup> Under the **Project Selection Process for Sub-Allocated Funding** adopted by the TPC on June 28, 2023 (Resolution 2023-13), requests for supplementary project exceeding \$500,000 require TPC approval. **This funding increase was approved by the TPC on October 25, 2023.**
