SUBJECT: Notification of **Administrative Modification #8** to the FY 2025 – FY 2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #11 to the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On June 2, 2025, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #8 to the FY 2025 – 2028 TIP and Modification #11 to the 2050 MTP.

Administrative Modification #8:

This action updates the previously published document and tables in the TIP. This modification adds a new grouped projects category and two new projects, which are both classified as Grouped Projects¹ (Bridge Rehabilitation and EV Charging Stations)

New Grouped Projects Category

Add a new grouped projects category – **Electric Vehicle Charging Stations and Alternative Fuel Stations** to facilitate adding projects funded under the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Formula Program as well as other federal programs aimed at promoting alternative fuels.

North Broadway EV Charging Station

Add a new grouped project under the **Electric Vehicle Charging Stations and Alternative Fuel Stations** category to install an Electric Vehicle charging station at Days Inn at 1987 North Broadway. 70% of the project cost will be funded under the federal Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure (EV) program. The 30% local match will be provided by the developer.

Johnston Road (KY 3367) Bridge

Add a new grouped project under the **Bridge Maintenance, Rehabilitation or Reconstruction** category to rehabilitate the Johnston Road (KY 3367) bridge over North Elkhorn Creek in Fayette County. 80% of the project cost will be funded under the Federal Bridge Program with a 20% state match provided by KYTC.

¹ The identification of Grouped Projects involves a commitment of additional funding by the project sponsor. The additional funding maintains financial constraint of these documents. A listing of Grouped Projects has been included in the TIP allowing planning process stakeholders and the general public to be informed of the types of potential projects that may be added to the TIP by Administrative Modification. TIP actions for these projects will not require additional public review, demonstration of fiscal constraint, or a conformity determination (if applicable).
