

This modification to the STIP will become part of the 2016 STIP end of Federal Fiscal Year 2017 "fiscal constraint" recalculations.



The KYOVA Interstate Planning Commission has approved the enclosed item for inclusion in the FY 2016-2019 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). KYOVA's Public Participation Process was implemented during the TIP amendment procedure. The amendment consists of highway projects for Cabell and Wayne counties in West Virginia and Greenup County, Kentucky, as well as transit projects for Cabell and Wayne counties, West Virginia. All the highway and transit projects met the air quality/conformity requirement through the Interagency Consultation (IAC) concurrence on the projects' status.

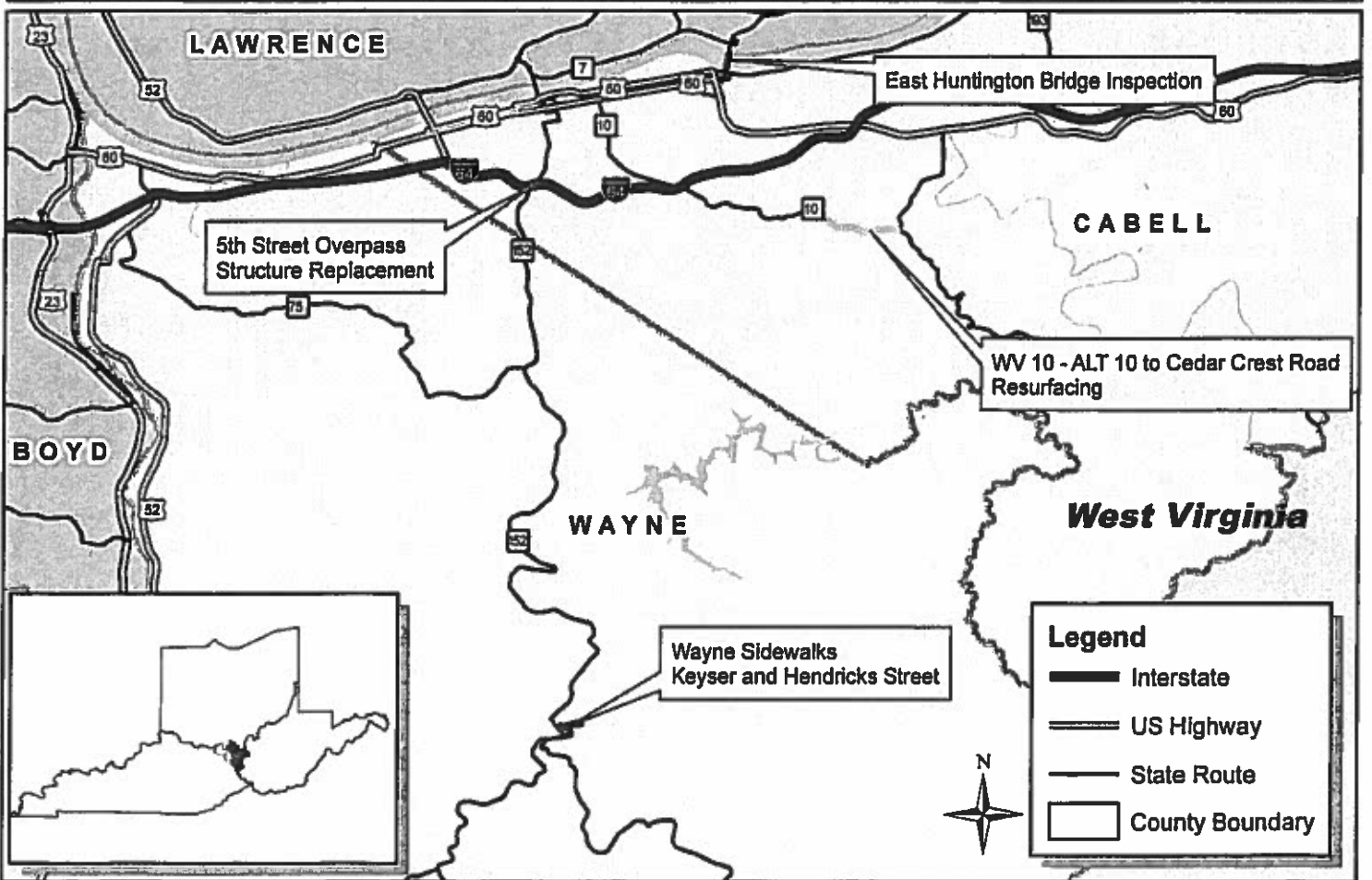
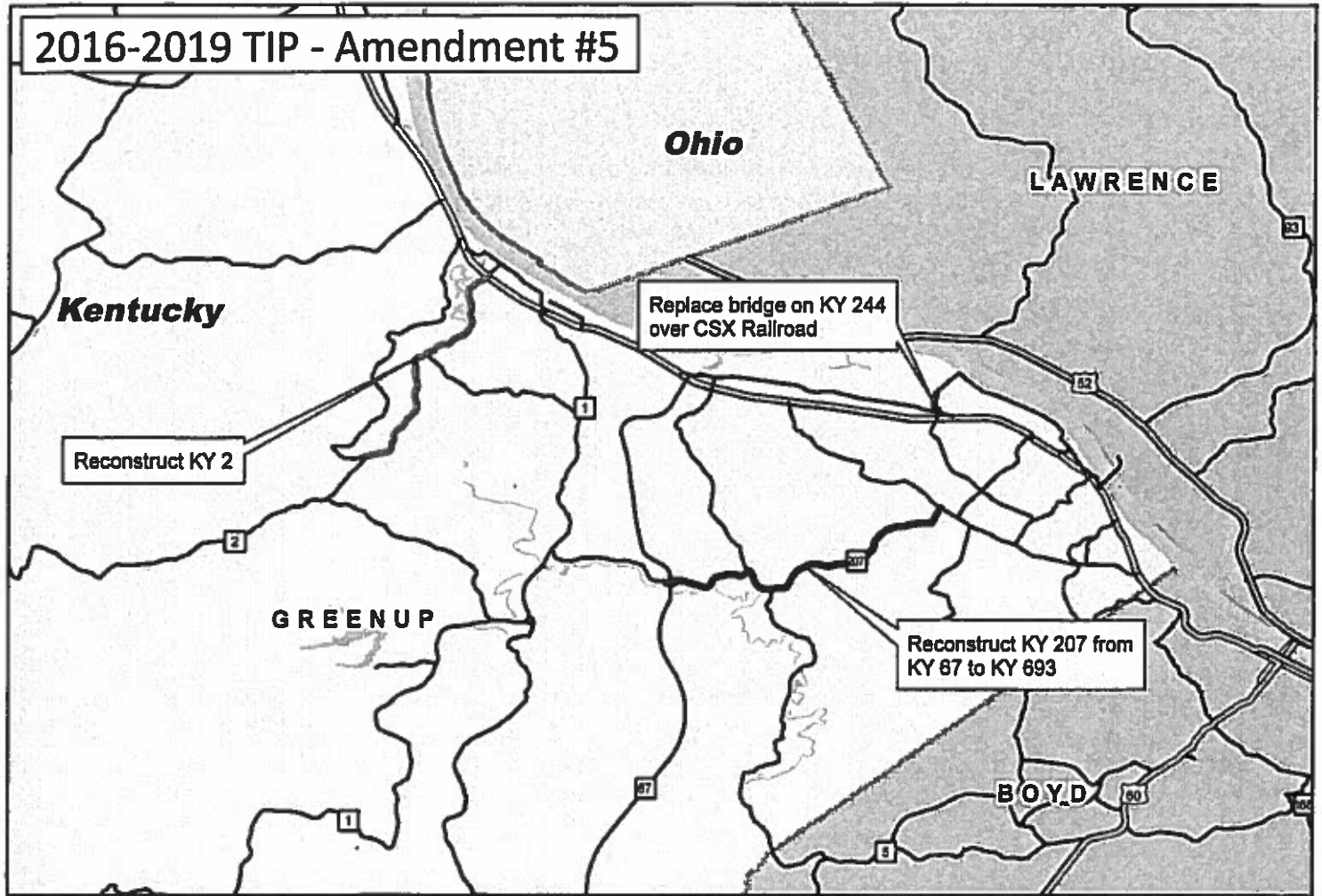
