SUBJECT: Notification of Administrative Modification #3 to the FY 2017–FY 2020 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #17 to the 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On July 27, 2017, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #3 to the FY 2017 – 2020 TIP and Modification #17 to the 2040 MTP.

Administrative Modification #3:

This action updates the previously published TIP document and tables. This modification is considered Grouped Projects* (Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Projects; Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities, Intersection Improvements for Safety or Efficiency) which does not impact financial constraint of the TIP.

The modification is:

- Table 6A – LFUCG – Armstrong Mill Sidewalks - add to project \$25,000 in funding for utility phase (\$20,000 federal CMAQ funds) and \$1,228,400 for construction phase (\$982,720 federal CMAQ funds).
- Table 6A – LFUCG – Oxford Circle Sidewalks - add to project \$3,000 in funding for utility phase (\$2,400 federal CMAQ funding) and \$61,218 for construction phase (\$48,974 federal CMAQ funds).
- Table 6A – LFUCG – add a project to improve Mercer Rd at Greendale Rd including \$85,000 in funding for design phase (\$68,000 federal CMAQ funds); \$75,000 for right of way phase (\$60,000 federal); \$60,000 for utility phase (\$48,000 federal); and \$772,300 for construction (\$617,840 federal).

* The identification of Grouped Projects involves a commitment of additional funding by the project sponsor. The additional funding maintains financial constraint of these documents. A listing of Grouped Projects has been included in the TIP allowing planning process stakeholders and the general public to be informed of the types of potential projects that may be added to the TIP by Administrative Modification. TIP actions for these projects will not require additional public review, demonstration of fiscal constraint, or a conformity determination (if applicable).
