I. Proposed Action:

Modify the FY 2011-2014 STIP to include the ARRA TIGER Grant funded project:

Appalachian Regional Short-Line Rail Project in Kentucky

Location: Various Counties

Project Description: This ARRA TIGER Grant will support work for the R. J. Corman Railroad Appalachian Regional Short-Line project through various counties in Kentucky for replacing cross-ties and ballast; bridge and underpass repairs, and resurfacing of rails.

Phase: Construction

Fund Type: ARRA TIGER Funds

Estimated Cost: \$16,200,000

Funding: TIGER - \$12,964,443

State - \$200,000


