I. Proposed Action:

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) hereby requests the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to modify the FY 2011-2014 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the following projects.

Location: Statewide Rural Areas

Scope of Activity: Kentucky Public Transportation Transit Projects. Add the following project to the Kentucky Public Transit Capital Discretionary D2010-BUSP-049 (State of Good Repair). The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet/Office of Transportation Delivery is making an application for rural/small urban transit systems statewide. The funds will be used to purchase replacement buses, radio replacements, on board camera, CE & A & E services, renovation and acquisition of bus equipment and transit facilities for Statewide Rural Areas in Kentucky.

Funding: Federal Transit Administration Section 5309 Discretionary Capital Apportionment


Cost: Federal Share: \$5,901,848 with toll credit match
