REALIDIKY WILL YOUR KENTUCKY LICENSE FLY

Federal REAL ID enforcement begins May 7, 2025.

You'll need a Kentucky REAL ID OR a form of federally approved ID to board commercial flights within the U.S., enter military bases or federal buildings that require verified ID.

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF ID THAT FLY:

- Kentucky REAL ID driver's license, permit <u>OR</u> ID card with a star that looks like this
- Valid passport
- U.S. passport card
- U.S. military IDs (and dependent IDs)
- Permanent resident card
