To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come:

- WHEREAS, In Kentucky work zones, 905 crashes and 228 injuries occurred last year; and
- WHEREAS, In a typical five-day workweek, an average of seven motorists and one worker are killed around the nation in work zones; and
- WHEREAS, Safer driving behaviors such as remaining alert, obeying posted speed limits and wearing seat belts would dramatically reduce the number of traffic-related injuries and deaths in work zones; and
- WHEREAS, Since 1999, nearly every state across the country has implemented work zone safety and awareness campaigns; and
- WHEREAS, Kentucky continues to inform and educate individuals about the importance of work zone safety through partnerships between the public and industry leaders;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANDY BESHEAR, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby proclaim April 26-30, 2021, as
