Comments (number of people reached, effectiveness of the technique, what you would do differently, etc.): Flyers were distributed to approximately 20 locations throughout study area. From an informal survey of a few flyers after the event, it looks like 5-10 people actually pulled off the tabbed reminders – applied to the entire group- this method appears to potentially reach 100 to 200 people. The public meeting drew approximately 150 people to comment. Obviously, many of them live along the route and had responded to additional news stories and variable message boards. While maybe not the driving force in generating public meeting attendance, the flyers at best directly caused people to go and at worst served as a reminder to those who already had decided to attend.
