

# The Difference between County of Residence and County of Dockage

This is for County Clerks and their deputies only.

## County of Residence

- County of Residence is directly associated with where the customer lives **NOT** necessarily where the boat is located.
- This impacts which county can file a lien on that customer's boats.
- It is changed from the customer account page by clicking edit.

## County of Dockage

- The County of Dockage is where the boat is actually docked. And it is the county that taxes the boat for the years it was docked in any given county.
- KAVIS requires a situs when the County of Dockage is different from the Owner's County of Residence during a title application.
