SUBJECT:

Revised Prequalification for Work Items

I-30 Traffic Signals and G-Lighting

Effective with the September 2015 bid letting, the prequalification work items Traffic Signals and Lighting will change. A Prime or a Subcontractor must be Pre-Qualified by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Division of Construction Procurement prior to bidding on these work items.

Below are the additional necessary minimum requirements to be prequalified in these items.

I30 - Traffic Signals

Provide documentation that a minimum of one (1) current company personnel has been certified by International Municipal Signal Association (IMSA) as a Traffic Signal Field Technician Level II or Traffic Signal Bench Technician Level II or Traffic Signal Construction Technician Level II.

G - Lighting

Provide documentation that a minimum of one (1) current company personnel has been certified by International Municipal Signal Association (IMSA) as a Roadway Lighting Technician Level I.

A letter requesting these work items be updated, along with the proper documentation, is to be submitted to the Division of Construction Procurement. Contractors who do not provide the necessary updates will have their Traffic Signals and/or Lighting work item removed from their Certificate of Eligibility at the close of business on August 31, 2015.
