US 60 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT OVER CUMBERLAND RIVER**

United States Army Corps of Engineers Navigation Branch will be required to be notified 30 days in advance of any work that will be taking place in the navigational channel in order to issue a Notice To Navigation Interests for all commercial navigational traffic that transits the Cumberland river. Before all pre-construction and pre-demolition meetings Owen Traughber (USACE\Nashville Navigation branch) is to be notified and provided an option to attend these meetings via in person, teleconference or virtual. The United States Army Corps of Engineers Navigation Branch are required to be on site during the demo of the navigational span of the old bridge during the river closure along with their survey boat to conduct an onsite survey and report to the USCG before the navigation channel is reopened and confirm that all debris has been removed from the river bottom.
