fences will not be permitted. Selective manual clearing shall be used to provide only clearance necessary to permit the removal and replacement of the fence. The cost of this clearing shall be incidental to the unit bid price for "REMOVE & REPLACE FENCE". In select locations, temporary fencing may be required as directed by the Engineer. Temporary fencing will not be measured for payment and will be considered incidental to the bid item "REMOVE & REPLACE FENCE".

- 8. Asphalt Pavement Ride Quality requirements, in accordance with section 410 Category "A" of the Standard Specifications, shall apply on this project.
- 9. Portable Changeable Message Boards furnished by the contractor shall be retained by the contractor upon completion of the project.
- 10. INLAID PPAVEMENT MARKERS (IPMs) will be used in lieu of Type 5 Pavement Markers on this job. Place two (2) IPMs per groove where Type 5 Pavement Markers would be located according to the Standard Drawings.
- 11. There is a quantity of "LEVEL & WEDGING PG 64-22" set up to correct irregularities. The quantity for irregularities may or may not be necessary and will be placed at the discretion of the Engineer.
- 12. There is additional quantity of "ASPHALT SEAL COAT", "BASE FAILURE REPAIR", "ASPH PAVE MILLING & TEXTURING", "BLOW UP/RELIEF JOINT", etc. set up to be placed if needed as directed by the Engineer. Only the quantity used shall be paid for.
- 13. The speed limit on this project will be reduced to 55 mph while lane closures are in place. Any time work is suspended the speed limit will revert back to 70 mph. Also, double fine signs are set up in the project to be installed while workers are present in the work zone.
- 14. Asphalt Millings from the project shall become the property of the Contractor. The transfer to the Contractor shall all be incidental to "ASPH PAVE MILLING & TEXTURING".
- 15. The specified completion date for this project is November 15, 2017. Contrary to section 108, liquidated damages will be charged during the months of December 2017 through March 2018.

Special Note for intermediate Completion Date, Fixed Completion Date and Liquidated Damages

Anderson and Mercer County

Item No. 7-2049 & 7-2050

This project has an Intermediate Completion Date and a Fixed Completion Date.

Contrary to Section 108.09, Liquidated Damages of \$5,000 per calendar day will be assessed for each day work remains uncompleted beyond the Intermediate Completion Date of November 15, 2017 for all work except permanent fencing.

Contrary to Section 108.09, Liquidated Damages of \$5,000 per calendar day will be assessed for each day work remains uncompleted beyond the Fixed Completion Date of December 31, 2017 for permanent fencing.

Contrary to Section 108.09 of the Standard Specifications, the disincentive fee will be charged during those periods when seasonal limitations of the Contract prohibit the Contractor from working on a controlling item or operation. This includes the months from December through March.

All liquidated damages will be applied cumulatively.

All other applicable portions of Section 108 apply.
