SPECIAL NOTE FOR PAVEMENT MARKING MODIFICATIONS

This Proposal includes drawings depicting anticipated pavement marking modifications associated with a Louisville Metro Public Works (LMPW) sidewalk project along the route to be resurfaced (See Coordination Special Note). LMPW intends to install temporary markings to match the included layout in advance of resurfacing activities. This new layout, unless modified by KYTC, shall be implemented during permanent striping on the final asphalt surface.

Per Section 713.03.01 of the Standard Specifications, the Contractor shall still be required to submit a record of existing pavement markings prior to beginning resurfacing activities. The Department requests these records be submitted at least two weeks prior to milling or paving in order to coordinate all desired changes between the District Traffic Engineer and the Contractor. All changes will be returned to the Contractor to ensure the desired modifications can be performed during final surfacing. As the Contractor is responsible for implementing any pavement marking changes, it is highly recommended any questions are addressed to the Project Engineer prior to striping. Any incorrect markings will be removed and replaced with the proper markings at the Contractor's expense and in a manner approved by the Engineer.

COORDINATION OF WORK WITH OTHER CONTRACTS

Be advised, there may be an active project(s) adjacent to or within this project. These may be KYTC administered contracts or work being performed as part of a KYTC issued encroachment permit. The Engineer will help coordinate the work of any other Contractors or permit holders within the limits of this project. See Sections 105.06, 107.06 and 107.14 of the Standard Specifications.

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer a minimum of 14 Calendar days prior to beginning work. The Engineer shall contact Steve Kurowsky with Louisville Metro Public Works to ensure there are no conflicts with other active projects. LMPW will have a contractor performing curb & gutter and sidewalk installation that will need to be completed prior to this resurfacing work. LMPW anticipates that this work will occur in spring of 2023. The Contractor shall not begin resurfacing activities before coordination with LMPW has occurred. KYTC will not entertain any monetary claim for delays associated with this coordinated effort. Once resurfacing & final pavement markings are complete, the Engineer shall notify Steve to allow LMPW to complete any remaining work on their project.
