Special Note for Asphalt Milling and Texturing BELL (KY 74)

Begin paving operations within **2 weeks** of commencement of the milling operation. Continue paving operations continuously until completed. If paving operations are not begun within this time period, the Department will assess liquidated damages at the rate prescribed by Section 108.09 until such time as paving operations are begun.

Contrary to Section 408, the Department will retain possession of the 2,000 Tons of the material obtained from the milling operations. Deliver this material to the State Maintenance facility in Bell County. Quantities in excess of the 2,000 Tons will become the property of the contractor.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR: The Department considers transfer of millings to the state maintenance facility to be a part of the construction project, therefore truck operators are subject to receiving prevailing wages.

Special Note for Asphalt Milling and Texturing (KY 2079)

Begin paving operations within **48 hours** of commencement of the milling operation. Continue paving operations continuously until completed. If paving operations are not begun within this time period, the Department will assess liquidated damages at the rate prescribed by Section 108.09 until such time as paving operations are begun.

Take possession of the millings and recycle the millings or dispose of the millings off the Right-of-Way at sites obtained by the Contractor at no additional cost to the Department.
