Payment

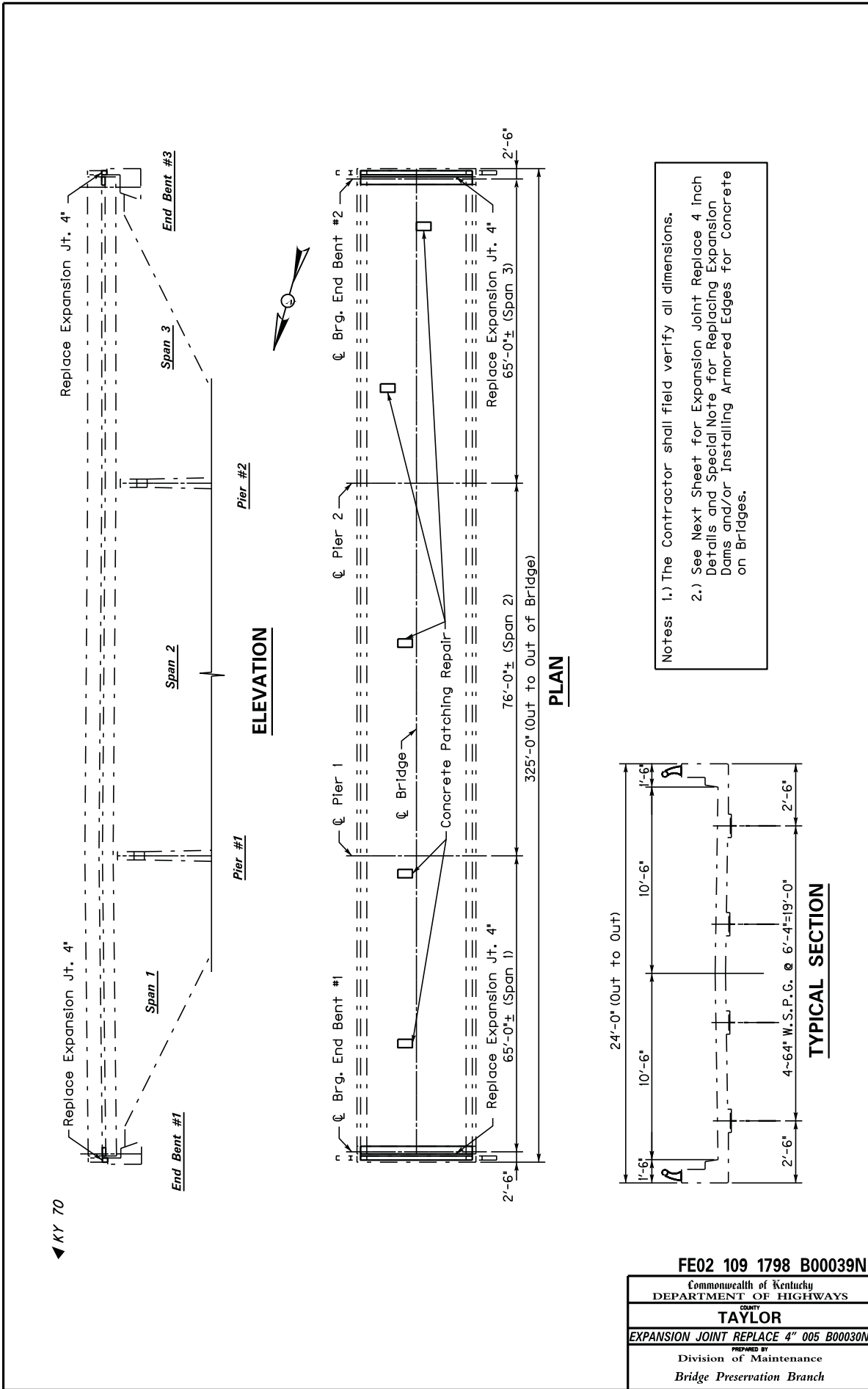
Payment of the contract lump sum amount for "maintain and control traffic" shall be full compensation for all items necessary to maintain and control traffic on this project. All traffic control items shall remain the property of the contractor when the work is complete.

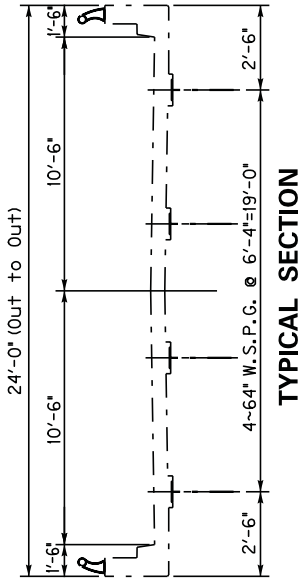
Maintain one usable 12 foot lane. Flagging or traffic signals shall be used. If traffic signals are used the Contractor shall use flagging to minimize impact on school bus traffic when school is in session. The Contractor shall be responsible for establishing the dates and times when school bus traffic will impact the job site. Should the work specified in the contract not be completed by the end of the 2013 season see Section 614.03.02 of the Standard Specification the Contractor must restore all lanes of traffic while not working between the 2013 season and the 2014 season.

Maintain one usable 10'-6" foot lane. Flagging or traffic signals shall be used. If traffic signals are used the Contractor shall use flagging to minimize impact on school bus traffic when school is in session. The Contractor shall be responsible for establishing the dates and times when school bus traffic will impact the job site. Should the work specified in the contract not be completed by the end of the 2013 season see Section 614.03.02 of the Standard Specification the Contractor must restore all lanes of traffic while not working between the 2013 season and the 2014 season.
