SPECIAL NOTE FOR LIQUIDATED DAMAGES
117GR15P047-FE01

In addition to the requirements of Section 108.09, the Department will assess Liquidated Damages in the amount of \$200 per hour for each hour or part of an hour, for each road, that KY 120, KY 270, or KY 1063 remains closed to through traffic beyond the time allowed for road closures by the Traffic Control Plan.

If culvert removal and installation begin before April 1, 2016, on either KY 120 or KY 270, in addition to the requirements of Section 108.09, the Department will assess Liquidated Damages in the amount of \$750 per day for each calendar day or part of a calendar day, for each road, that the Pipe Arch or Structural Plate Pipe Arch, backfill, embankments, shoulders, and asphalt base and leveling and wedging remain uncompleted after the time allowed for road closures by the Traffic Control Plan.

Contrary to Sections 108.07.03 and 108.09, the Department will assess Liquidated Damages as specified above for the months of December through March, regardless of whether seasonal or temperature limitations prohibit the Contractor from performing work on the controlling item or operation.

The Department will assess Liquidated Damages in the amount specified in Section 108.09 for each calendar day or part of a calendar day that any item of work remains uncompleted after July 31, 2016.

The Department will apply all liquidated damages accumulatively.

All other applicable portions of Section 108 apply.
