

Purpose and Need

This project was undertaken to address the current roadway deficiencies, which include narrow shoulders and inadequate sight distance at intersections and over hilltops, and to improve safety, mobility and connectivity for this region of Carter County.

Tonight's Meeting

The purpose of today's meeting is to introduce the project to the public and obtain information and feedback on the alignments and design options. The project corridor begins near the quarry and extends east to the I-64 interchange.

As can be seen in the graphic above, there are four alternatives under consideration. Two closely follow the existing roadway and the other two cut cross-country from the beginning to near the truck stop. The cross country roadway section would be two lanes with paved shoulders, with truck climbing lanes over the hill and a two way left turn lane from where it rejoins the existing road through the I-64 interchange. The options along the existing corridor have two different roadway sections from the beginning to KY 182: one would have two lanes with paved shoulders, and the other would be three lanes with curb and gutter. Both would be three lane with curb and gutter from KY 182 up to the interchange.
