The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has scheduled this Public Information Meeting to provide all interested persons an opportunity to review the project information and provide comments to the Project Team. The project consists of the proposed replacement of the Weisenberger Mill Bridge. The recommended alternative is being presented tonight for review. This alternative consists of minor approach work with construction of a one-lane truss bridge over South Elkhorn Creek with the existing stone abutments rehabilitated and left in place.

This meeting will be Open Format from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. No formal presentation will occur. Various stations are set up around the gymnasium to provide information in each of the following areas concerning the project: Environmental, Design, Right of Way and Utilities, and Construction.

Project Team members are available at each station to provide specific discipline information and answer any questions you may have. Please review the information presented tonight and ask any questions you may have.

After reviewing the information at each station, we ask that you provide written comments concerning your views of the proposal to the Project Team.

Written comments will be accepted tonight and for 15 days after this meeting.
