PURPOSE AND NEED Improve traffic operation, congestion and safety caused by poor roadway geometrics.

METHOD OF DESIGN The selected consultant shall utilize the CADD Standards for Highway Plans (version 2.0) policy in the development of the Highway Plans.

PROJECT FUNDING	State Funds
SCOPE	Conduct preliminary engineering studies to identify appropriate improvements to Mount Washington Road to improve safety and relieve congestion. This will include traffic flow analysis, typical section, line and grade, dependable cost estimates, identifying right of way and utility conflicts and possible mitigation, identify drainage issues, traffic control considerations, necessary structure modifications, and possible enhancements to signing and pavement markings. Both build and low-build options need to be considered for funding flexibility. The Cabinet will prepare the appropriate environmental document.
ENVIRONMENTAL	Department will provide all required environmental services.
PHOTOGRAMMETRIC SERVICES	The Department can help the selected consultant gain access to LOGIC mapping through Metro Louisville. The mapping will need to be supplemented with field survey.
STRUCTURE DESIGN	Department  If necessary the selected consultant shall do the necessary engineering services to submit to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet an Advance Situation Folder(s) for the appropriate applicable structure(s). Upon submission of the folder(s), a determination will be made whether the structure design will be performed by the Department or by the consultant.  Prequalification in the area of structure design is required to be identified in the consultant's Response to Announcement.
GEOTECHNICAL SERVICES	Department will provide all services.
TRAFFIC	Department will provide historical traffic information and any projections needed.
