SCOPE	<i>Five consultants will be selected (1,2,3,4,5). The consultant ranked first will be awarded first choice of the five (5) packages. The consultant ranked second will be awarded choice of the remaining four (4) packages. The consultant ranked third will be awarded choice of the remaining three (3) packages. The consultant ranked fourth will have choice of the remaining two (2) packages, and the consultant ranked fifth will be awarded the remaining package. Consultants must be prepared to make selection at the time of notification of ranking by the selection committee. Inspection packages are randomly listed and do not necessarily reflect the order of importance or anticipated contract size.</i>

If requested the firm(s) must then be prequalified in the appropriate area(s).
