PURPOSE AND NEED	To improve safety and increase the capacity of the I-65/KY 222 Interchange at Glendale and to ensure sufficient capacity and desirable ingress and egress for the Glendale Development Site.
ROUTE	I-65 - MP 88 to 88.2
METHOD OF DESIGN	The selected consultant shall utilize the CADD Standards for Highway Plans (version 2.0) policy in the development of the Highway Plans.
DBE REQUIREMENT	None
PROJECT FUNDING	The services for this contract will be paid for with federal funds.
DBE REQUIREMENT	The consultant team shall include a DBE Participation Plan with their response to announcement. An additional page will be allowed with the project approach in the Response to Announcement to convey this plan. A maximum of 4 points will be considered.

SCOPE OF WORK

The selected consultant will be required to provide Phase II final roadway design, including the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right of way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans and cost estimates on KY 222 from Mud Splash Road to US31W and I-65 from MP 88 to 88.2. The consultant will be required to provide Final Structure Design plans.
