PURPOSE AND NEED	Currently, a single interchange exists on the Nunn Parkway for Edmonton and Metcalfe County. Traffic from the industrial park to the western end of Edmonton passes through the inefficient intersection of KY 163 and US 68 in downtown Edmonton. The purpose of this project is to improve safety and mobility of motorists and commercial vehicles traveling from east to west in Edmonton and Metcalfe County by providing an additional access to the Nunn Parkway and therefore, creating an alternative route for traffic along US 68 and KY 80.
